Cork&Co Preventive and Maintenance Care Instructions

A: Protect against excessive sunlight and heat.

- 1. Excess sunlight can fade and discolor the cork leather.
- 2. Heat will dry out the leather and cause further damage.

B: How to remove spots and stains:

- 1. Remove excess liquid up a quickly as possible with a clean 100% cotton white absorbent cloth or sponge.
- 2. If necessary, use clean lukewarm water only and let dry naturally. Do not dry with hair dryer, etc.
- 3. If water is used, clean the entire area where spot occured seat cushion, arm, etc.

Do not rub too much.

C: How to remove butter, oil or grease:

1. Wipe excess butter, oil or grease off the leather with a clean 100% cotton white dry cloth.

Then leave it alone as the spot should dissapear into the leather in a short period of time.

2. Do not apply water or try to wash the butter, oil or grease spot.

D: How to remove chewing gum:

Place ice cubes in a plastic bag and apply on the chewing gum. Wait several minutes, lift the ice bag and remove the chewing gum.

E: General Care:

In order to maximize the natural look of the Cork leather we suggest cleaning when requird with a wet wipe or with our "CorkLeather Cleaner". After clean if necessary, proof the area again with our "CorkLeather Waterproofing".

DO NOT USE CHEMICALS, SADDLE SOAP, CLEANING SOLVENTS, FURNITURE POLISH, OILS, VARNISH, ABRASIVE CLEANERS, SOAP OR AMMONIA WATER.

Vacuum as a routine cleaning. Keep moist. Humidify if climate is dry. These are recommended or suggested methods of cleaning. The manufacturer is not responsible for damage incurred while cleaning. Always try the cleaning method in a hidden area first to see results. Items that are damaged as a result of incorrect washing cannot be refunded or replaced and in many cases cannot be repaired!
